Long ropes will be available to borrow if you do not have one. The ideal is 10' for Juniors and 12' Seniors. I ask for a donation of a minimum of £1.00 towards EAAA for borrowing the rope. Please bring cash on the day

Horses/Ponies need a headcollar & 12' rope. A 'dually' is fine for training if you feel you need more control at the start of the day, otherwise normal headcollar or rope halter'

Horses must be 2 years old and over and able to be lead safely in company.

Handler needs a current standard riding hat, gloves, and work boots.

Please note that entries are limited to 6 per group in the outdoor ménage.

We take entries on a 'first come, first served' basis.

Cancellations/Refunds – No refunds will be given, unless I have more than 7 days' notice prior to the event, unless you can find someone to take your place, or I have someone on a waiting list that can fill it.

Format of the day: There are 2 sessions, and I will fill in the am slot first, so I know that I have full numbers

If you have never been to a Horse Agility Training/Competition Day, I will start with an introduction and do some work with you on using the 12' rope and how to lead using body language and cues and how not to rely on the rope leading onto Liberty. Everyone will do a course walk.

Followed by 'Playtime' under my guidance and supervision and ending the session with a fun competition. Everyone gets a rosette and a score sheet.
