
LITTLE BRADLEY CHURCH RIDE SUNDAY 21st JULY 2024

The appropriate entry fee must be enclosed with the Entry Form or paid by BACs, and must be received by the Secretary by close of business on 7th July 2024.

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. No refunds will be given.
- 2. Riders must report to the Secretary on arrival to collect a number which MUST be worn.
- 3. It is recommended that all riders carry a charged mobile phone, and mobile phone numbers must be entered on the Entry Form. It is essential that each group of riders carries at least one charged mobile phone for emergencies. RIDERS CAN RETIRE FROM THE COURSE AT ANY STEWARD CHECKPOINT BUT MUST NOTIFY A STEWARD IF DOING SO IN ORDER THAT THE SECRETARY CAN BE NOTIFIED.
- 4. All riders must hold third party liability insurance, to the value of £2m or above.
- 5. When mounted, all participants MUST wear a riding hat with a fastened chinstrap to the current official standards. High visibility vests and body protectors are recommended.
- 6. Riders may not ride in wellington boots, and whips may not exceed 30" in length. Spurs and draw reins or similar are not permitted
- 7. Riders are expected to show due consideration to other riders and act in a polite and courteous manner to all. Discourteous and disrespectful behaviour towards others, including the organisers and the stewards who have voluntarily given up their time, will not be tolerated and the organisers reserve the right to ask any rider to leave the course.
- 8. No Dogs (unless kept in well ventilated vehicles)
- 9. All riders to keep to the marked course only, and riders must obey instructions from stewards.
- 10. All riders under 16 years of age must be accompanied by an adult.
- 11. A Veterinary Surgeon and Farrier will be on call.
- 12. Horses/ponies must be 4 years old or over.
- 13. No Stallions
- 14. All horse/ponies to be up-to-date with their flu and tetanus vaccinations
- 15. Please ensure that you do not muck out your horse box/trailer into the lorry park. Please take all litter (including muck) home with you.
- 16. Please do not leave horses/ponies unattended, including those tied up to the outside of lorries/trailers in the lorry park.
- 17. Any jumps will not be flagged and riders take them at their own risk.

The organisers, their representatives, stewards, helpers and landowners do not accept any liability for accidents, loss, damage, injury or illness to riders, spectators or any other person, property, animals or horses/ponies in connection with or arising out of this ride. All riders and persons attending the ride do so entirely at their own risk. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall indemnify the organisers against any legal action arising from any accidents or incidents whatsoever. By completing and signing this form (either wet ink or electronically) and returning with payment you accept these terms and conditions, recognising that this is a risk sport and confirming that you have the competence to undertake the ride on which you are entering.
