## SHOW RULES

- 1 – EVERYONE SHOULD HAVE THEIR PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE. Neither organisers nor persons acting on their behalf accept any responsibility or liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness that may occur to competitors, spectators, or any other persons, property, servants or animals. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify against any legal action arising from such an incident.
- 2 – Officials and competitors only are allowed in the ring. Photographers will be allowed as long as they do not disturb the class
- 3 – You may be asked for your horses/pony passport or vaccination card when booking in. Please ensure you have these present.
- 4 – The judge's decision is final.
- 5 – Ages of horse/pony will be taken as of 1st January.
- 6 – Competitors entering class on the lead rein are NOT eligible to enter classes off lead rein.
- 7 – Abusive and foul language or cruelty to any person present or horse/pony will not be tolerated. If any such incidents occur the competitor/spectator will be asked to leave and may be banned from future shows.
- 8 – Correct dress, footwear and hard hats must be worn and secured when mounted on the showground. Hats must conform to the latest standard. The organiser accepts no responsibility or liability for any injury, arising from a failure to comply with this regulation. Body protectors are optional and will not be penalised.
- 9 – Classes will run as per schedule unless exceptional circumstances or lack of entries cause alterations or amendments – notification will be given ASAP.
- 10 – Pedestrian walkways will be allocated please do not enter with horses. Horses/ponies must walk around the show ground unless in the designated collecting rings.
- 11 – The show is on private property with permitted access from the owner to you, please remove all litter and where possible any droppings.
- 12 – Horses/ponies attending today should have an up to date vaccinations (flu and tetanus) and be regularly wormed.
- 13 – Stallions are permitted, however must be handled by persons 18 years and over and must be identified by a bridle disc
- 14 – If your horse/pony has been in contact or on a yard where strangles has been present they must have cleared a six week quarantine period.
- 15– All competitors must abide by the above rules and failure to do so you maybe asked to leave the showground.
