#### Penalties will be as follows:-

Knockdown – 4 faults 1<sup>st</sup> refusal – 4 faults 2<sup>nd</sup> refusal – 8 faults 3<sup>rd</sup> refusal – Elimination Fall of Horse or Rider – Elimination

Class 38 is a clear round class aimed at complete beginners.

Class 39 will be run as one round, with the last four jumps against the clock.

Classes 40 - 45 will run as normal with a jump off against the clock, unless we should run late and we are running out of daylight, then they may be run as only one round, with the second half of the course timed.

Competitors Please Note: In the interest of equine welfare -

For Jumping competitors entering classes in other Rings:

No Horse/Pony may compete in any more than 3 Classes in Ring 5.

For Competitors entering only Classes in Ring 5:

No Horse/Pony may compete in any more than 4 Classes.

### **HRF Show Rules:**


- 1. In the interest of Covid safety, competitors are requested to remain at their transport until the class prior to their si called, at which time they may then warm up for their following class.
- 2. The Committee reserves the right to refuse entry.
- 3. Hard hats to current regulation impact standards must be worn, with straps fastened, at all times by those mounted.
- 4. Proper Footwear with a defined heel must be worn at all times when mounted.
- 5. The organisers and landowners will not accept liability for any injury, accident, damage or loss caused by or to any person, animal or property, whether competing, attending or otherwise.
- 6. Horse and Ponies must be 4 years old or over to compete in the ridden classes.
- 7. No child under the age of 3 will be allowed to compete.
- 8. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
- 9. Protests or complaints must be made **in writing** within 20 minutes to the chairman or the secretary, with a £10.00 deposit, which will be returned if the complaint is upheld.
- 10. Ages for all competitors are taken as of 1st January 2021.
- 11. Litter bins are provided for your use, so please use them, or, preferably, take your litter home with you.
- 12. Lorries and trailers must not be mucked out onto the showground.
- 13. Interference from outside the ring will result in elimination.
- 14. Disqualification for the day can result from:
  - a. Excessive use of whip or spurs b. Dangerous riding
  - c. Riding a sick or lame animal
- d. Any breach of the rules
- 15. In the interest of safety, it is only permissible to walk your ponies in the trailer lines, cantering among them is not allowed.

<u>THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL</u> They have volunteered to help us raise funds today, so please treat them with the respect they deserve. Thank you.

\*Although we have tried hard to organise the running order as best as possible, some classes may clash. Out of courtesy to the Judges, classes will only be held open for 10 minutes. Once the steward has closed the gate, no more competitors will be allowed into the ring
