The latter stems from a well set on head and neck combined with a good length of shoulder. The movement should be smooth and graceful with a true pointing of the toe. To achieve these qualities the Hack must be extremely well schooled.

The two highest placed horses in classes 64-69 will qualify to enter at the RIHS. In Class 68 the two highest placed smalls and the two highest placed lightweights will qualify and in Class 69 the two highest placed middleweights and the two highest placed heavyweights will qualify. mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cms, capable of carrying not more than 12 stone 7lbs. Small Hunters are to be included in this category. Rider any age. All places are to be recorded (run under 2022 rules)

Class 69 RIHS Amateurs Heavyweight Hunter,

mare or gelding, 4 years old and over, exceeding 153cms, capable of carrying more than 12 stone 7lbs. The Middleweight Hunters to be included in this category. Rider any age. All places are to be recorded (run under 2022 rules)

Ponies must be owned, registered and ridden by BSPS members to compete except for classes 70-73 which must be registered with BSPA, Classes 22-23 with AHS and Classes 57-63 with BSHA.

In BSPS classes the highest placed pony (not already qualified) from the first three ponies placed in each class will qualify. The following classes are qualifiers:

3-7, 15-17, 22-23, 25-28, 29-30, 34-36, 37-42, 52-56. Competitors qualifying for this show must submit their entries online within 48 hours of qualifying.

Highest placed amateur and highest placed junior in each class qualify for amateur and Junior Supreme Championship finals to be held at BSPA World of Colour Championship Finals. Cards to be shown and qualification card signed.

The British Show Horse Association

RIHS BSHA Qualifying Classes - Held under the rules of the British Show Horse Association. Horses must be registered with the Association and all Owners, Exhibitors and Riders must be Association Members. Riders must be 15 years of age or older. Registration numbers to be quoted on entry forms.

Classes (57-63) are qualifiers for The Royal International Horse Show. The first prize winner will qualify to compete at the final. If already qualified the second will qualify, if the first and second are already qualified then the third will go forward.

Horses competing at the RIHS and qualifying shows in the Sport Horse Breeding of Great Britain classes at their Affiliated Shows cannot compete in Hack and Riding Horse classes at the same show. This does not apply to SHB (GB) Ridden Sport Horse classes.

The three highest placed prize winners in all Open Affiliated classes will qualify to compete in the BSHA Classic of the Year Final. The Finals will be held at the BSHA Hunter & National Championship Shows in September 2022. The BSHA offer a Novice, Young Rider and Amateur rosette in each **Open** class and a Championship rosette for each section (with the exception of Open Working Show Horse).
